## DIGGING DEEPER

1. We *praise God* for saving grace. In the original Greek, Ephesians 1:3-14 is one long run-on sentence of joyful, overflowing praise to the Lord. Read the text with a special attention to the great gladness of Paul's heart. Reflecting on your walk with Christ, when have you had the most profound moments of praise and worship? How often does great joy well up from your heart?
2. We become godly by training grace. Read Titus 2:11-14. According to this text, grace trains us, instructing us to renounce ungodliness and pursue godly lives. What worldly passions might the Lord helped his people to renounce? Which good deeds has he made his people zealous for?
3. What is the purpose of Christ in Titus 2:14? How does this help *you* to renounce worldliness and pursue good deeds?
4. We endure hardship and suffering by strengthening grace. Think of some of the people that have been most inspiring in your walk with Christ. What people who have helped you grow? Have those people experienced hardship and pain in their lives, or have they had it "care-free"?
5. Read II Corinthians 12:7-10. What painful times has the Lord seen you through? Can you give testimony of the sufficiency of God's grace in times of hardship and trial?
