## DIGGING DEEPER

1. Joel's prophecy describes events of an era called "the last days." How are we to understand that phrase? Does that refer to a narrow window of time, or something broader?
2. What do the following passages teach us about this era called "the last days"? How is God helping us to face that which comes?

Acts 2:15-21

Hebrews 1:1-4

II Timothy 3:1-5

II Peter 3:1-4

3. God's transforming grace is observed in the renewal of Simon Peter. When have you observed God's hand giving you or someone else the ability to do something they could not do before? How is this giving perspective to your life right now?
4. How does the picture of Acts 2:17-18 inform the body life of Bethel Grace? Our fellowship group? How does Colossians 3:12-17 reinforce this (especially v.16)?
5. What exactly did the scoffers in the crowd accuse the disciples of in Acts 2:13? How is this ironic in view of the teaching of Jesus recorded in Luke 5:33-39? What is the principle Jesus is teaching?
6. Did Paul have Luke's Pentecost account in mind when he wrote Ephesians 5:18-21? What are the parallels between these passages? How is God calling you to apply these things to your life? Our church?
