DIGGING DEEPER

1. In Acts 22:1, Paul asked the Jewish mob to hear the defense of his ministry. This becomes the vehicle of Gospel testimony. Reflecting on 1Peter 3:13-16, when should Christians be ready to make a defense for their faith? How should they go about doing it?
2. Giving your testimony is a matter of explain God's gracious intervention in your life. Following Paul's example, what are some noteworthy aspects of your life prior to knowing Christ? Where did your struggles with sin and sorrow lay?
3. Paul came to understand the authority of Christ in the most dramatic of ways when Jesus revealed himself to him. How has the fear of the Lord been introduced into your life? In what ways were you made aware that Christ is Lord and you are accountable to him?
4. Reflect on Romans 10:8-12. We are saved when we call upon the name of the Lord for salvation. When did you do this? What effects have you experienced in your life as a result?
5. According to Acts 1:8, we will receive power from the Holy Spirit to be witnesses for the glory and grace of our King and Savior. Pray for the Spirit's anointing on your life and that he will lead you to people to share your testimony with. What believers can be encouraged by hearing your story? What unbelievers need to hear your testimony? When will you share with them?
