DIGGING DEEPER

1. Even as Peter and John were being placed under arrest, 2000 more people were coming to faith in Christ. Can you think of other examples of the Gospel advancing and bearing fruit in “unlikely” circumstances?
2. Reflect on II Timothy 2:8-13. What does Paul say about his situation? In contrast to that, what does he say about the Word of God? How does this passage give inspiration to our mission as church family?
3. In ancient times, the language of boldness was used to describe people committed to the truth above public opinion. Peter is a tremendous example of boldness in Acts 4-5. What aspects of his boldness appeal to you and help you? What other living examples of boldness have encouraged you?
4. Acts 4:12 is a vitally important statement about God’s provision of salvation. How does it accentuate our need to be the witnesses called for in Acts 1:8? How are you doing in the practice of witnessing and evangelism? How can your group pray for you?
5. Acts 4:18-20 provide a concise summary of what it means to be a witness for Jesus Christ. What do you learn from this verse? How might Peter’s resolve in these verses be connected to what we read in Acts 4:8?
