SERMON REVIEW

Having expressed his gratitude for the Colossian church, and having presented a clear picture of the supremacy and sufficiency of Christ (chapter 1), Paul explicitly warns the Colossians against a heresy spreading in their city (chapter 2). Moving forward, Paul exhorts the church about the new life and Kingdom lifestyle that union with Christ leads to (chapter 3). Finally, Paul concludes his letter with a series of commendations and greetings. Even here, we see the supremacy and sufficiency of Christ in the relational lives of those serving His Kingdom.

3. Read Colossians 2. Where do you see the reality of spiritual warfare in that chapter? Where do you find the truths that indicate the victory we have in Christ?
4. Satan attacks the believer's assurance in multiple ways. One is to cause us to question our salvation. Another is to cast doubt upon the content and truth of God's word. Read Ephesians 6:10-20. How can we bolster one another in view of these attacks?
5. Read Ephesians 2:8-10. Like Archippus, we've been given ministry assignments in the midst of the battle. How do you discern God to be calling and equipping the others in your group? In your own life?
