DIGGING DEEPER

1. Reflect on Isaiah 3:8-9. In what ways do we see similar arrogance in the world today? How about in churches that claim to belong to Jesus?
2. To lead his people to repentance, the Lord is willing to shake societies. One key aspect of that is the removal of strong leadership. Instead there will rise immature leadership (3:6) or reluctance in relation to leadership (3:6-7). Do you see these dynamics at work in the world and/or church today?
3. Many women in Jerusalem were consumed by a spirit of superficial, external beauty. In this, they considered themselves superior to others. Reflecting on I Timothy 2:8-10, how does the beauty of godliness compare to this?
4. Isaiah 3:16-4:1 focuses on the women, but how does a similar spirit of pride, arrogance and self-display play out with men? What does godliness in the lives of young men (& women) look like? II Timothy 2:22-26)
5. Isaiah 4:2-6 presents a vision of future glory for the people of God. But do we need to wait for the 2nd Coming of Christ to manifest his Kingdom? (Titus 2:11-15)
6. How is the warning of Revelation 3:14-22 similar to the prophetic vision we studied in Isaiah? What warning must the church heed?
