DIGGING DEEPER

1. The Lord God is sovereign over all the nations of the earth. Reflecting on the following passages, what do you learn about God's command over global superpowers and small countries alike?

Isaiah 40:22-23

Daniel 2:19-23; 4:17

Habakkuk 1:5-6

Proverbs 21:1

2. The Lord is at work to cleanse and purify the faith of his people so that they lean entirely on Him (Isaiah 10:20-21). What false sources of support do you see Christians leaning on today? How about you? Are you prone toward leaning on any of these as well?
3. The Lord wants to convey courage to our hearts amidst the hardships of this world. Reflect on John 16:33. Did Jesus promise his disciples that they would not face painful times? What did Jesus tell us to expect? What is he calling us to do?
4. God conveyed courage to the people of Judah on the basis of the brevity of the suffering to come (Isaiah 10:24-25). How does Peter provide a similar word of encouragement to the church? Reflect on I Peter 5:6-11 and share what God is teaching you.
