**What’s distinct about the Messiah and His reign?**

1. The Messiah will reign as the \_\_\_\_\_ Davidic King (11:1, 10)
2. The Messiah will be uniquely \_\_\_\_\_ with the Holy Spirit (11:2-5)
3. The Messiah will bring \_\_\_\_\_ to the natural realm (11:6-9)
4. The Messiah will bring \_\_\_\_\_ among the nations (11:10-16)

## DIGGING DEEPER

1. Jesus is both the shoot and the root of Jesse (King David's father). What is the difference between the two? Why is it significant that He is both?
2. Reflect on Revelation 1:4-8. What do you find in these verses that accord with what we learned from Isaiah 11? Why does Jesus want us to know that He is the Alpha and the Omega? How does this help us?
3. The Messiah will be uniquely anointed with the power of the Holy Spirit. Reflecting again on Isaiah 11:2-5, what qualities of true leadership stand out to you? Looking forward to His perfect global leadership, how does this inform any leadership influence you have? How can you be praying for the leaders of Bethel Grace?
4. The Messiah will bring total harmony to the natural realm, including the animal kingdom. Which animal do you look forward to interacting with during His reign?
5. In Romans 8:18-25, Paul applies the doctrine of nature's redemption pastorally. What future realities are taught there? What does Paul want this vision to provide the church with? (Hint: what's the last word of verse 25?) How does this apply to you?
6. Isaiah looks forward to the day when impure tribal jealousy will be healed (Isaiah 11:13). Where is envy or impure jealousy manifesting itself in your life? What is God's healing for that condition? (Ephesians 4:29-32)
