QUICK REVIEW

The book of Job tells the story of the suffering of a godly man. Unbeknownst to Job (and his friends), God held him forth in heaven as a man exemplary of genuine faith. In Job 1-2, we are given a “behind the scenes” perspective on the life of Job and the severe trials he underwent. What we learn about Job here sheds light on the dialogue that occurs in the many chapters that follow.

3. Read James 1:2-12. What is God's purpose when trials (hardships, difficulty, painful experiences) fill our lives? What are we to do when they come?
4. As Satan pointed out, Job experienced abnormal productivity and increase of possessions in the land. Because of this, Satan claimed Job only worshipped God for what God gave him. Is there an area of your life that has been greatly prolific? How might this be an area of testing? How would you respond if it were taken away?
