## QUICK REVIEW

The Gospel of Luke is a detailed, carefully-researched account of the birth, ministry, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Luke chapters 4-9 present the Galilean Ministry of Christ. In this passage, the Galilean ministry is culminated with the Transfiguration of the Lord Jesus Christ. A mighty heavenly endorsement is given related to the Son of God after the crucial sayings of Luke 9:23-27.

## Read Luke 9:28-36

## DIGGING DEEPER

1. Luke 9:28-36 provides only a short glimpse of the glory of Jesus Christ. For a fuller picture of the exalted Messiah, read Revelation 1:9-20. Why do you think God revealed the Messiah to John in this way? Why has it been revealed to you?
2. In II Peter 1:16-21, Peter reflects back on his experience on “The Mount of Transfiguration.” He does so to provide his readers with multiple levels of assurance. Reading carefully, what does Peter want to assure you of?
3. Luke explicitly links the Transfiguration to sayings Jesus spoke forth in the previous section. In view of the glory of Jesus displayed at the transfiguration, what are some ways that you might be able to take up your cross and follow him (Luke 9:23-27)?
4. Read Matthew 17:1 & Mark 5:37. Out of his 12 disciples, Jesus seemed to have three that he was preparing for special levels of leadership. Who are the people God has placed in your life to bless and strengthen in the faith? How can you go about supporting their growth in Christ?
