QUICK REVIEW

The Gospel of Luke is a detailed, carefully-researched account of the birth, ministry, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Luke 9-19 records Jesus movement from Galilee to Jerusalem. This section emphasizes the mission of Jesus to “GO” and proclaim the Kingdom of God to a world under judgement.

Read Luke 10:1-16

Christ commands His followers to “go”

DIGGING DEEPER

1. When it comes to evangelism, many Christians have a “seed planting” mindset. Share the Good News, plant seeds, and God will open their hearts in His time. That’s a good thing. But how might a “harvest” mindset differ from a “seed planting” mindset? How can we rightly encourage people to put their faith in Christ, now?
2. Jesus said that we should pray and ask God to send workers into the harvest. We pray for the things that are most important to us. How are things ordered in the Lord’s Prayer? Read Matthew 6:9-13. What priorities for prayer do you learn?
3. The Lord’s instruction has an emphasis on eating whatever the hosts provide (verses 7-8). Considering the fact that the Trans-Jordan was a region with lots of Gentiles, what’s the significance of this? What are some ways we can affirm and not offend people of other cultures as we share Christ with them?
4. Not all “sent ones” feel confident about the mission they are given. Does evangelism come easy or hard for you? When experiencing hesitation, what encouragement can you find in the following passages?
