QUICK REVIEW

The Gospel of Luke is a detailed, carefully-researched account of the birth, ministry, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Luke 9-19 records the Lord's movement from Galilee to Jerusalem. In this passage, the power of Jesus over the demonic realm is once again displayed. This time, however, His opponents accuse Him of performing His work with a very dark, evil power.

DIGGING DEEPER
