QUICK REVIEW

The Gospel of Luke is a detailed, carefully-researched account of the birth, ministry, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Luke 9-19 records the Lord’s movement from Galilee to Jerusalem. In this passage, the power of Jesus over the demonic realm has been revealed. But some who observed asked still another sign, an even greater one. Jesus takes this opportunity to assess their spiritual health and give words of warning.

Read Luke 11:29-36

1. Ask for ears to hear the _____ of Christ (11:31-32)
2. Ask for eyes to see the _____ of Christ (11:33-36)

DIGGING DEEPER

1. Read II Thessalonians 2:9-12. Are miraculous signs certain evidence that God is at work? According to these verses, where is salvation found? In observing miracles, or in something else?
2. How can we reconcile the fact that Christ came performing miracles to display His Kingdom, and then at the same time, asserting that we should not test God by seeking them?
3. What do these passages teach you about the value of Scripture in knowing God? How has Scripture been used in your life to know God?
