### QUICK REVIEW

The early Galilean ministry is long concluded. Jesus and His disciples have finished the trek from Galilee in northern Israel down to Jerusalem in the south. Now Jesus makes entry into Jerusalem. In the so-called "Triumphal Entry," we see Jesus Christ in various aspects of His person and ministry. Seeing Him clearly, we worship Him with joy. Trusting in Him personally, we enter the peace Jesus came to bring us.

## DIGGING DEEPER

2. Jesus Christ is King. According to Zechariah 9:9, what was the significance of the Messiah's entry by way of a colt, the foal donkey? Where is the Lord calling you to manifest that Christ-like blend of humility and strength?
3. Read Psalm 63:3-7. The Pharisees wanted to subdue the praise occurring that day. Is it possible that we some Christians might hinder others in true worship? How have you seen or experienced personally a negative spirit toward certain styles or expressions of worship?
4. Jesus was grieved that the people of Jerusalem, who spoke often of peace, did not really know thing things that made for peace. Where do we see similar delusion today in secular society and even in local churches? How have you seen or experienced turmoil among people that claim to champion peace?
