QUICK REVIEW

The early Galilean ministry is long concluded. Jesus and His disciples have finished the trek from Galilee in northern Israel down to Jerusalem in the south. Jesus has entered the city. It's the final week of the life of Christ, and Jesus is teaching and preaching in the temple courts. The Jewish authorities have categorically rejected Jesus and are plotting his death by crucifixion. Seeking to lure him into a death trap, they ask a question attempting to render him guilty of insurrection, and they do so in a public setting. Jesus replies on the spot with unparalleled wisdom.
