MY STORY

1. What examples of humility and servanthood (apart from the obvious and greatest example in Christ) have you been inspired by?

QUICK REVIEW

It’s the final day of the life of Christ, and Jesus is preparing His disciples for His departure. The Jewish authorities have categorically rejected Jesus and are plotting his death. They find an unexpected ally as one the twelve, one Jesus’ closest disciples, offers his help in turning Jesus over to them.

In the section, we continue in the Upper Room with Jesus and His disciples. They have just shared the Last Supper. But a dispute is happening among the disciples as the evening continues on. He took this opportunity to teach the true nature of greatness in His kingdom.

DIGGING DEEPER

1. Read John 13:12-17. By the work of the Holy Spirit, Christians are to be servant-hearted people. In what situations are you prone toward “desiring from” others rather than “giving to” others?

2. In Luke 22:28, Jesus commends the disciples for their endurance with him. Endurance is a key aspect of faith in Christ. Have you ever experienced moments of wanting to lose heart and give up? What encouragement do you find in Romans 5:1-10?

3. Satan demanded to sift the disciples like wheat. We are to be constantly aware of the awesome reality of spiritual warfare, but even more, of the greater vision of Christ interceding for us. How do these passages encourage you?
