## Questions for Application and Fellowship

### MY STORY

1. Can you think of the time when you were most on fire for the Lord? Is it now? Was it earlier? When was that time that you were most living and active in your faith? What was your walk with Christ like?

### QUICK REVIEW

The Gospel of Luke is a detailed, carefully-researched account of the birth, ministry, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. In this passage, the resurrected Christ appears to his disciples for the first time. He appears suddenly and startles them as they cannot comprehend that He is alive. Jesus takes measures to prove He is truly alive. As he addresses them, we also glean qualities of a living church.

### Read Luke 24:36-49

3. Bethel Grace should be a church reaching out to the lost with the message of salvation. Each of us should do this based on our own personal experience of salvation in Christ. How have you personally witnessed God's grace in your life? What is your testimony?
4. Bethel Grace needs to be clothed in God's power. Read Acts 1:6-8. What does the Holy Spirit empower God's people to do? How specifically will you ask God to empower Bethel Grace? How specifically will you ask God to empower you?
